Alma and Primo VE January/February 2022 Release Highlights

Analytics – With the February release, users can define data visualization projects as objects.

Course Reserves – Using the withdraw item action now checks for Course Reserve materials.

Resource Management – Coming in February, users will gain the ability to export NZ-linked bibliographic records from the IZ.

Resource Sharing – With another February feature, the ability to use Job Category as an input parameter for the resource sharing borrowing Terms of Use.

User Management – When exporting a list of users, select the Extended Export option to export primary identifiers.

ERM SPRING CLEANING

With Spring around the corner, "Spring Cleaning" time quickly approaches. Like everything else, there are some things you can do in Alma to improve your patrons' ER experience in Primo. Here are five key cleanup projects.

- Let PALS manage your eLM or recommended OA electronic collections from the NZ. If you have not switched yet, Dani will be contacting you regarding moving those collections.
- Review your electronic collections in the IZ. Ensure you have your current subscriptions correctly activated and deactivate or delete any electronic collections you dropped. If you would like to work with PALS

staff to get started, book either of the following sessions at the <u>Carrie Curie – PALS Booking</u> page:

ERM: One-on-One Institutional Collection Activation Review Session (web session) – 1 hour 30 minutes or ERM: One-on-One Institutional Collection Activation Review Session (web session) – 45 minutes.

- Review your standalone portfolios in Alma. If you have the titles activated in a CZ-linked collection, you no longer need the standalone portfolio.
- Lheck your portfolio counts for selective package electronic collections. You want to ensure you activate all individual titles you purchased.
- → Bibliographic records without inventory display in Primo unless suppressed. Delete bibliographic records without inventory. Also, the link resolver can experience problems when you have an inventory-less bibliographic record and one with a portfolio. Delete inventory-less bibliographic records to guarantee that your users see the link to the resource.

There are also several other cleanup projects you can embark on in Alma with electronic resources. These five cleanup projects have a high impact, improving your users' discovery and access experience in Primo. Keep in mind that once you get some of these projects tackled, you might want to turn on extra functionality in Primo, like:

- Report a Broken Link
- UnPaywall QuickLinks one-click to OA full-text access
- QuickLinks one-click to full-text access


